ADVANTAGES OF BEING A SENIOR TECHNICIAN OF THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS -INDIA (IEI)

I. NTTF Diploma holders are eligible to become a Senior Technician of IEI by virtue of NTTF diploma.

II. Financial commitment to become Sr. Technician:

The fee to become a Senior Technician is Rs. 5800/- which includes registration fee, entrance fee, composite subscription fee, fee for membership pack and study material, fee for identity card and fee for prospectus.

III. Privileges of being a Sr. Technician include:

- 1. Can participate in all technical discourses organized by IEI
- 2. Entitled to write after his/ her name 'Sr.Tech.IEI'.
- 3. Can use the library of IEI
- 4. Receive Technician's Journal free of cost
- 5. Can avail guidance classes provided by IEI
- 6. Can attend Technician/ Student Convention/ International Conferences and seminars, and present papers.
- 7. Railway concessions to eligible candidates to attend annual convocation.
- 8. Can enjoy the facilities and benefits while abroad through professional societies with whom IEI has a bilateral agreement.
- 9. Can contest election to become a member of All India Technician's committee of IEI.

IV. Entry to AIME:

- 1. All the Senior Technicians are provided with a laminated photo ID card.
- 2. Can take up Section 'A' (Diploma) and Section 'B' examinations to get their AMIE qualification after paying the applicable fee (visit website https://www.ieindia.org for more information).
- 3. The exams will be conducted in English and is held twice in a year.
- 4. They need pass 4 stipulated subjects for Section A (does not include Engineering Maths and Science) instead of 10 subjects for +2 non diploma candidates. Each exam is of 3 hours duration.
- 5. Can take up maximum 4 exams in one session and the minimum grade to pass the exams is 'C' grade
- 6. After passing Section A, candidate is required to register for Section B in any of the declared Engineering discipline. It includes Electrical, EC & E, Mechanical Engineering, and Production Engineering & Computer Engineering which are relevant to our students. In Section B, they need take up 6 compulsory subjects and 3 optional subjects from the group declared by IEI.
- 7. Once admitted, the candidate need complete Section A exams within 6 years from the date of admission and within another 6 years for Section B papers.
- 8. Candidates acquiring minimum Grade C in subjects of engineering branch in Section B can separately apply for a project work and laboratory experiment which is a part of the course.
- 9. The grade card and certificates are issued by IEI during their annual convocation held in the succeeding year.

V. Post-graduation:

- 1. They also stand a chance to pursue a post graduate programme of IEI in selected Engineering disciplines at Birla Institute of Technology, Mesra, Ranchi.
- 2. As per AICTE circular, AIME passed out candidates can take up M.Tech. Courses in any of the Indian universities.
