Training of Trainers (ToT) Program

HAPPY TEACHERS' DAY!



NTTF and DoTE Tamil Nadu successfully conducted the second Training of Trainers (ToT) program batch. Supported by MSDE's SANKALP scheme and the World Bank, the program aimed to enhance pedagogical and technical skills.

The Training of Trainers (ToT) program empowers 401 beneficiaries. In the 3-month model, 219 are beneficiaries, 119 completed training and 100 are ongoing. In the 1-year model, 182 are beneficiaries, of which 68 have completed the training, and 114 are currently undergoing training.



Starting on March 15, 2023, the ToT program featured six-week online training, followed by specialized in-campus training in CNC Programming, Automotive Automation, and Junior Software Development. Practical sessions took place at NTTF's Bengaluru facilities, with an enriching industrial visit to FESTO India Private Limited.

Culmination and Impact- Training of Trainer academy

The Training of Trainers program culminated on June 21, 2023, with a grand valedictory function attended by distinguished guests, including Dr. Vinay IAS, Commissioner of Technical Education, DoTE Tamil Nadu. The event celebrated participants' dedication and highlighted the program's role in enhancing technical education skills. NTTF's commitment to fostering excellence in technical education and skill development was underscored through the successful completion of the program's second batch.

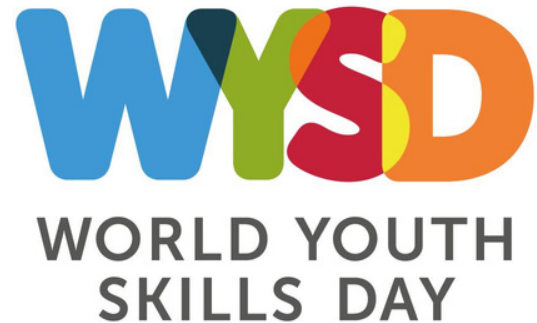
World Youth Skills Day 2023
